NOTES: This is only a planning guide. Please refer to your course catalog for official requirements. An effort should be made to schedule courses in the year indicated, although some adjustments may be necessary as not every course is offered every semester. A grade of C- or better is required for all University Breadth requirement courses, all minor courses and all Core Requirements.

A – LEAD100/200/300 satisfies the Social/Behavioral Science with a C- or better

B – COMM 212 satisfies the minor COMM elective with a C- or better

**Restricted electives chosen from the list provided by the Organizational and Community Leadership minor requirements.

Students in the Human Relations Administration major will be required to earn a C- or better in all major courses (Core Courses and the required minor in Organizational and Community Leadership). The HDFS 449 Internship course will require an overall grade point average of 2.5 and a major grade point average of 2.75. Students who cannot successfully complete the major courses after a second attempt will not be permitted to remain in the major. Students can appeal this requirement.
