## THE PROCEDURE

This Guide will provide quick links but you should also consult an Advisor and the UD Registrar policies.

- Your courses go through a preliminary evaluation and are assigned a UD course number (if they are already on the Transfer Credit Matrix) or a Transfer Elective designation (166, 266 etc) if they are not yet on the Matrix.
- Once you are a matriculated student, you can seek re-evaluation for courses with Transfer Elective designation by emailing a specific request to the departmental contact on the Registrar's page.
- You may be asked to provide a copy of a course syllabus if more information is needed.



## NOTES

- You must earn a C or better for a course to transfer.
- You must meet the Residency Requirement relative to credits completed at UD.
- The credits will transfer but the grade will not be factored into your GPA.
